



Flexibility is key

Flexibility is the keyword in the Reflex modular sofa programme. The basic idea is relatively simple. A sofa is actually a collection of fauteuils with and without armrests. In combination with a pouffe, a table and a corner element, this provides countless possibilities. And if you add seating elements that swivel through 180 degrees, removable covers, plus the possibility of fitting or removing armrests, the Reflex really does have something for everyone.

Characteristics

The Reflex owes its flexibility to its separate seating elements and removable covers. The seating elements can be positioned, turned and repositioned on the frame any way you like but they can also be placed separately on the floor. There is also a hand grip hidden in the seat to make moving the elements easy. There's even a matching table top and a corner element. You can play with the shape and appearance of the Reflex to your heart's content.

Let's say you opt for a three-seater frame, 3 seating elements (2 with a low back and 1 with a high back) and a pouffe. You can then position these so you're facing each other with the pouffe in the middle, or simply sit next to each other with the pouffe on the floor. You might decide to fit an armrest (very easy to do with 2 screws and an Allen key) or you might not. And if you want something different tomorrow, you just change the order of the elements and voilà, a new Reflex. Incredibly flexible!

A sofa that could be fully recycled was the basic principle behind the design of the Reflex. The result is a sofa that is not only 100% flexible but also 100% recyclable!

Seat:

- Metal frame with springs.
- Covered with moulded foam

Back:

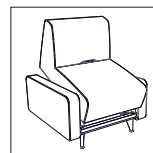
- Plywood, 9, 15 and 18 mm, glue according standard DIN 68 705 IF 20.
- Covered with moulded foam.

Aluminium base powdercoated or upholstered with:

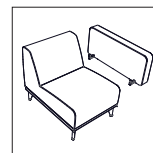
- Sledge legs, supplied with a powder coating as standard. Chromium is also available at no extra cost. With felt gliders.
- Aluminium legs, supplied polished or matt as standard (depending on the type of leg). Powder coating is also available at no extra cost.
- Beech-wood legs, natural stained.

Upholstery:

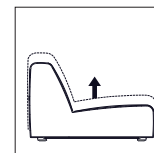

Instructions for Reflex combination page

The following information will help you to combine the various Reflex elements:

- The chart works from left to right. First choose the integrated leg/armrest, then the armrest, then the frame and then the seating element (there are endless variations on the last two steps). You then choose the armrest and finally the integrated leg/armrest.
- If you wish to link multiple frames, be sure that you have ordered sufficient legs and connectors.
 - * For each frame you will need either:
 - 1 integrated leg/armrest and 2 legs
 - 1 integrated leg/armrest and 1 sledge leg
 - 2 sledge legs
 - 4 legs
 - * For each corner frame you will need either:
 - 2 sledge legs and 1 corner sledge leg
 - 5 legs
 - * To link 2 frames you will need one connector set (consisting of 2 connectors).
- In the case of a combination of an integrated leg/armrest (armrest extending to the floor) and multiple frames, you must also choose a matching type of leg.
- An integrated leg/armrest can only be used at the ends of the seating combination.
- 75 cm seating elements do not fit frames based on 60 cm, or vice versa.
- You may combine different back heights in the same combination.
- You may combine different fabrics in the same combination. So a seating element may have a different fabric to the armrests and the upholstered frame.
- You may have only one seating height in the same combination.
- You can have different types of armrest in the same combination.
- You can have different leg types in the same combination as long as these are the same height (42 or 47cm).
- You can use integrated leg/armrests and side panels either on the right or the left.
- It is possible to order extra seating elements.
- Seating elements can also be placed directly on the floor (without a frame).
